Energy resources are precious, and climate protection is essential. The EUROGATE Group is committed to the respectful and conscious use of energy sources and the reduction of CO₂-emissions. Therefore, each of the companies listed below commits to continuously improving their energy efficiency and achieving net-zero CO₂-emissions in Scope 1 and 2 (*) by 2040. By 2030, we will reduce CO₂-emissions in Scope 1 and 2 by 50% compared to 2022.



We commit to the following principles:

- We regularly record and assess our energy consumption and CO₂-emissions. This analysis forms the basis for our binding targets.
- We appoint responsible individuals for the development and implementation of reduction measures.
- We provide them with all necessary information and resources to be able to achieve our goals.
- We involve our employees in this process and inform the public about our goals and results.
- We comply with all applicable energy regulations and other binding requirements.
- We consider energy efficiency and CO₂-emissions in planning, design, and new acquisitions, and involve our suppliers.
- Each one of us plays a crucial role on this path to sustainability.



*Scope 1 and 2 are the CO₂-emissions that can be directly influenced by our activities at EUROGATE, such as the consumption of diesel, electricity, gas, heat, and cooling. CO₂-emissions here refer to all greenhouse gas emissions in the context of climate protection, meaning all climate-damaging greenhouse gases are converted into CO₂-equivalents. Net zero means that we primarily avoid and reduce CO₂-emissions. If it is not possible to avoid all CO₂-emissions, the remaining emissions will be offset through appropriate climate protection projects. Upon customer request, we will offset CO₂-emissions to the corresponding extent.
